

## **Notice of Decision**

Project Title: Ventura County 2022 Air Quality Management Plan for the 70 ppb 8-

hour Ozone Standard

**Project Location:** Statewide

**Public Meeting Date:** January 26, 2023; Agenda Item #23-1-2

**Project Description:** Adoption of the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District 2022 Air

Quality Management Plan for the 70 ppb 8-Hour Ozone Standard (2022 Plan). The 2022 Plan demonstrates that Ventura County will attain the 70 ppb 8-hour ozone standard by 2026 and meets other Clean Air Act State

Implementation Plan (SIP) requirements.

This notice is to advise that the California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board), as the lead agency, approved the above project on January 26, 2023.

CARB determined that, pursuant to title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15168, the Ventura County Air Quality Management Plan for the ppb 8-hour Ozone Standard (2022 Plan) is within the scope of a prior environmental analysis prepared for the 2022 Plan certified by Ventura County (Negative Declaration - SCH 2022080714) and the 2022 State Strategy for the State Implementation Plan, entitled "Final Environmental Analysis for the Proposed 2022 State Strategy for the State Implementation Plan" (Final EA) and certified by the Board on September 22, 2022 (SCH 2021070211). The 2022 Plan does not involve any changes that result in new or substantially increased significant adverse impacts and there are no changes in circumstances or new information that would otherwise warrant any subsequent environmental review to the negative declaration or Final EA. An explanation of CARB's decision to not prepare a subsequent or supplemental EA for the 2022 Plan is included in Chapter VII of the Staff Report released December 16, 2022.
