

Notice of Decision

- Project Title:** Advanced Clean Fleets Regulation (SCH# 2021030340)
- Project Location:** Statewide
- Public Meeting Date:** April 27, 2023; Agenda Item #23-4-2
- Project Description:** The ACF regulation is an integral element of CARB's comprehensive strategy to achieve significant reductions of criteria pollutants and greenhouse gases needed to attain federal and state ambient air quality standards, address harms resulting from climate change, meet California's goals to decarbonize the transportation sector, and to protect the public health and welfare. The proposed regulation would primarily require certain fleets to deploy medium- and heavy-duty vehicle ZEVs starting in 2024, and would establish a clear end date to new medium- and heavy-duty internal combustion engine vehicle sales in 2036. This is the second of two public hearings on this item.

This notice is to advise that the California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board), as the lead agency, approved the above regulatory action on April 27, 2023.

CARB prepared and certified an environmental analysis (EA) in accordance with the requirements of its certified regulatory program under CEQA. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §15251, subd, (d)). The EA, included as an appendix to the Staff Report: Initial Statement of Reasons (Staff Report) prepared for the project pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, concluded implementation of the project may result in significant adverse environmental impacts. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval and CARB did not adopt a mitigation monitoring program. The Board made CEQA findings pursuant to Section 15091 of the CEQA Guidelines and adopted a statement of overriding considerations for this project.
