Request by E & S Management Corp. to amend previous the approved permit and donate \$134, 847 to the Los Angeles Audubon Society in-lieu of installing two nesting poles with three nesting platforms each and planting five trees (three Tecate Cypress and two Monterey Cypress) in and around Ballona Lagoon as part of mitigation and penalties incurred for the unpermitted removal of 11 unoccupied nests from four trees in Mariners Village apartment complex on Marina del Rey Parcel 113.
