Description: The adopted changes amend regulations regarding Klamath River Basin sport fishing by:

- Re-opening the Klamath and Trinity rivers to the take and possession of Chinook salmon.
- Instituting daily bag and possession limits for the fall and spring Chinook fisheries
- Establishing a quota and subquotas throughout the basin for the fall fishery

Determination: Adopted May 6, 2026 – The Commission has determined that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment.
