**Project Description:** The Magnolia Power Project is a 323-megawatt, combined-cycle natural gas facility. The project was certified by the California Energy Commission (CEC) in March 2003 and began commercial operation in September 2005.

**Project Modification:** The approved Petition to Amend the Commission Final Decision, modifies the Conditions of Certification (COCs) for the facility to allow for the use of stormwater for cooling purposes.

On April 8, 2026, the CEC approved the above-described project change pursuant to the CEC's regulatory program certified by the Secretary of the Natural Resources Agency under section Public Resources Code section 21080.5, finding that:

- The petition meets all the filing criteria of California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1769(a) concerning post-certification project changes;
- The new and modified COCs will not change the findings in the CEC's Final Decision, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1748
- There is no possibility that the change may have a significant impact on the environment, or the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act;
- The proposed change would not cause the project to fail to comply with any applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards;
- The findings required under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1748(b), are not applicable to this petition; and
- The proposed change does not meet the criteria requiring the production of subsequent or supplemental review as specified in California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15162(a).e
- Notice of the staff assessment was mailed to the CEC's list of interested parties and property owners of all parcels within 500 feet of any affected project linears and 1,000 feet of the project site as well as emailed to the MPP subscription list; and
- The staff assessment was posted to the docket on March 5, 2026, and was subject to a 30-day comment period.
