**Project Description:** Petition to Amend the Commission Final Decision for the Gateway Generating Station. The Gateway Generating Station (GGS), is a 530-megawatt (MW) combined-cycle, natural gas facility that was certified by the CEC in May 2001. It began commercial operation in January 2009. The facility is within the site complex of the existing Contra Costa Power Plant (CCPP) in Contra Costa County, just north of the City of Antioch, in Contra Costa County.

**Project Modification:** The approved Petition to Amend the Commission Final Decision to the Gateway Generating Station modified Condition of Certification (COC) AQ-SC12 and deleting AQ-SC13.

At the May 13, 2026, Business Meeting, the CEC approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the Secretary of the Natural Resources Agency under section Public Resources Code section 21080.5, finding that:

- The petition meets all the filing criteria of California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1769(a), concerning post-certification project modifications.
- The modifications will not change the findings in the CEC's Final Decision, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1748.
- The project will remain in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards, subject to the provisions of Public Resources Code section 25525.
- Any environmental impacts will be less than significant with mitigation with the modified conditions of certification.
- The proposed amendment to AQ-SC12 and deletion of AQ-SC13 do not meet any of the criteria requiring the preparation of subsequent or supplement review pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21166 or California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections 15162 and 15163.
