Description: The proposed changes amend Section 362, Title 14, California Code of Regulations, to add three new bighorn sheep hunt areas in San Bernardino County, increase flexibility for single zone bighorn sheep fundraising tags, and modify bighorn sheep hunt tag quotas.

Determination: Adopted April 16, 2026 – The Commission has determined that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment.
