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SUBJECT: NOTICE OF DECISION TO REEVALUATE PESTICIDE PRODUCTS

Pursuant to Title 3, California Code of Regulations (3 CCR) section 6255, the Director of the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR), files this Notice of Decision to Begin Reevaluation of Pesticide Products with the Secretary of the Resources Agency for posting.

This notice must remain posted for a period of 30 days for public inspection. Information regarding the products being reevaluated and where to locate the Director's Decision is set forth below.

Decision to Begin Reevaluation

Pursuant to 3 CCR section 6255, DPR gives notice that the Decision to Begin Reevaluation of specified total release fogger (TRF) pesticide products labeled for indoor consumer use containing one or more of the active ingredients: cyfluthrin, cypermethrin, esfenvalerate, etofenprox, etoxazole, n-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide, permethrin, piperonyl butoxide, pyrethrins, pyriproxyfen, s-methoprene, and tetramethrin was issued on June 29, 2026. As required by 3 CCR section 6253 and 6220, the Decision to Begin Reevaluation is based on the receipt of information indicating the use of the pesticide is likely to result in sufficient impacts to the environment or resources listed in 3 CCR section 6221 to require reevaluation.

DPR will commence a period of gathering data in order to render a determination during reevaluation required by 3 CCR section 6224.

DPR will accept comments electronically and by mail up to and including July 29, 2026.
